

NOTES ON THE PAHAPILL FAMILY BOOK

The **Pahapill Family Book** provides genealogy data and related information on descendants of people who lived in the late 1700s / early 1800s at the **Aadama farm** and homestead - in the village of **Võhma**, **Mustjala** County, **Saaremaa**, **Estonia**. However, known roots of their family name reach back to 1645 - to **Tõnnis Pahapill** (*ref. 1*), whose home was a few kilometers north of Võhma, in the "**Pahapilli küla**" / the Pahapill village, situated at a central part of the northern shores of Saaremaa - an island in the eastern part of Baltic Sea. On a Mustjala County map: <http://pahapill.ca/mustjala.htm> - the Pahapill village is located about a kilometre south of points 6 and 7, "Võhma" at points 3, 4 and 5 on the same map. An enlarged map of the Võhma village - with names of some of its farms/homesteads listed - is found through the website of <http://pahapill.ca/vohma.pdf>.

By choice, some individuals have been excluded from publicly posted version of the family tree and family book; as well, the public version does not list certain personal data on living individuals - instead, the word "private" is shown in place of such data.

Throughout the Pahapill family tree and family book, women are listed by maiden name. For aiding the process of finding certain branches of the clan in the family book, spousal names are also provided in some cases.

Due to the size of its content, the Pahapill Family Book is divided into two parts. Part 1 - chapters I, II, III-1, V-1 and V-2 - covers descendants of "**Aadama / Tehna**" **Laas Pahapill** (1828-1880) - second son of "Aadama" Karl Pahapill (1799-1820) and his wife Mare (1786-1866). "Aadama" and "Tehna" are names of the farms / homesteads where they were born or where they settled through marriage. **Tehna** is found in the "**Tehnaots**" part on the Võhma village map noted above (N.B. The map can be enlarged by "mouse-clicks"!), **Aadama** is found in the "**Kuresküla**" part of the village.

Chapter III-2 of Part 1 of the book contains genealogy data and related information on those of the "**Sillukse**" branch of Pahapill Family Tree - descendants of "**Sillukse**" **Jaan Pahapill** - son of "Kure / Aadama / Sillukse" Mihkel Pahapill (1855-1946) - younger brother of Karl Pahapill. **Sillukse** is situated in the village of **Järise** in Mustjala county - found in the central / western part on the county map noted above.

Part II of the family book, in its six-part chapter 6, covers descendants of Karl's first son, "**Aadama**" **Jüri Pahapill** (1825-1910) and his second wife Reet Muld (1835-1910).

It appears that the two sons – Mihkel and Toomas – of Jüri and his first wife Reet Tarvis (1812-1857) had no offspring.
